## Donate online.

To make a donation online, simply visit our [JustGiving page](#), click the purple donate button and follow the instructions. You can also donate directly to one of our projects listed on our [JustGiving homepage](#).

You can also set up a monthly donation via our [JustGiving page](#). First choose how much you would like to donate a month and then complete the rest of the online donation form.

Once you have confirmed your donation, don't forget to include a message with your name and reason for donating.

## Donate by text.

To donate to the brighterway general fund, simply text BWAY15 and the amount you want to donate to 70070. For example, if you wanted to donate £10, you'd text 'BWAY15 £10' to 70070.


